*** The Second District Chapter of Credit Unions, of which Citizens is a member, awards two \$500 scholarships each year.** Winners are determined based on the results of a test on credit unions and a guide to money. The entrant, parent, guardian, or grandparent must be a member of a credit union belonging to the Second District Chapter of Credit Unions to be eligible for these scholarships. *** The Family Involvement Board, a committee of the Iowa Credit Union League offers two different scholarship programs** The first scholarship program is for high school students planning to enter college. In this category, the FIB will award a **first place prize of \$1,500; second place, \$1,000; third place, \$750; and fourth place, \$500 to students in the state of Iowa.** The second scholarship program sponsored by the FIB is for nontraditional-aged and continuing education students. The non-traditional scholarship category will award **two \$1,000 scholarships.**

Entrants are required to write a 500 word essay. Entrants must have an account established in their own name and be a “member in good standing” at Citizens or another credit union that is a member of the Iowa Credit Union League to be eligible for these scholarships.
