## What you need to know about overdrafts and overdraft fees.

An <u>overdraft</u> occurs when you do not have enough money in your account to cover a transaction, but we pay it anyway. We can cover your overdrafts in two different ways:

- 1. We have standard overdraft practices that come with your account.
- 2. We also offer <u>overdraft protection plans</u> such as a link to another deposit account, which may be less expensive than our standard overdraft practices. To learn more, ask us about these plans.

This notice explains our standard overdraft practices.

#### What are the standard overdraft practices that come with my account?

We do authorize and pay overdrafts for the following types of transactions:

- Checks and other transactions made using your checking account number
- Automatic bill payments

We <u>do not</u> authorize and pay overdrafts for the following types of transactions unless you ask us to (see below):

- ATM transactions
- Everyday debit card transactions

We pay overdrafts at our discretion, which means we <u>do not guarantee</u> that we will always authorize and pay any type of transaction.

If we do not authorize and pay an overdraft, your transaction will be declined.

# What Fees Will I be charged if Citizens Community Credit Union pays my overdraft?

Under our standard overdraft practices:

- We will charge you a fee of \$27.75 each time we pay an overdraft.
- There is no daily limit on the total fees we can charge you for overdrawing your account.
- There is no charge on daily overdraft balances of \$5.00 or less.
